The individualized, service-oriented and personal approach is important to Dr. Lantzy. He and his staff are as hospitable as they are professional; both are of the utmost importance.



Growing Into the Future With a Team Approach

The new sterilization center and furnishings feature many hands-free operations, and improved disinfection controls offer decreased possibilities for cross-contamination. Additionally, a new water filtration/sterilization system by Vista Pure was installed. Its design enhances infection control and eliminates

The intraoral camera allows the patient to view the concerns we see clinically. Early detection is a preventive measure that can avoid more extensive treatment.

The digital radiograph affords doctor and patient the ability to see and discuss dental concerns below the gumline. In this photo, doctor reviews the proper fit of the implant coping.

The doctor also uses an intraoral camera, which allows him to take the patient on a "tour" of her mouth; where they can both see what's happening inside at the same time. In addition, digital x-rays, which can be enlarged to the size of the computer screen, allow the doctor to better share the images with the patient and explain his findings. Digital films decrease radiation exposure by 90 percent.

"Patients are better educated today, and like to be more involved with their care," explains Dr. Lantzy, "so we share in the diagnosis and planning process. We are always proactive for our patients' overall health." From the comprehensive initial exam of the teeth, gums, and supportive jawbone and joint, through the extensive offerings for overall dental care wellness, Dr. Lantzy and his patients approach dental care as a team.

water line stagnation while providing distilled quality water for the autoclave.

Dr. Lantzy's practice also is a step ahead through his use of CEREC, a technology that allows for dental restoration using 3D photography, digital impressions, and CAD/CAM. CEREC allows procedures such as crowns, veneers, inlays and onlays to be done in a single visit, saving time.
